


HELLO. I am a woman executive. Every day I make many important decisions. The first decision I must make every day is which silk tie to wear with one of my twenty-seven navy blue suits.

THESE ARE WOMEN EXECUTIVES going home from work.




THIS IS MY FAMILY. Two wonderful girls, and of course, the "little gentleman."

Today he's really got the rag on.





But the boss seems satisfied.




THIS IS MY SECRETARY, BRUCE. I've never made a move on him. Color his shirt puce.

I'll have my boy call her boy.






SOME DAYS I EAT LUNCH IN MY OFFICE and watch "All My Children." Is this un-executive of me?

Some days U.S. Supreme Court Justice Thurgood Marshall eats lunch in his chambers and watches "All My Children." Is this un-just of him?






THIS IS A COMMERCIAL AIRLINER. I prefer flying on it to our company jet. With all the people around, I don't get as many invitations to join the mile-high club.
